## 2021 Archaeology Discovery Weekend PRESENTERS (Arranged Alphabetically)

**Kent Bramlett** is Professor of Archaeology and the History of Antiquity at La Sierra University, having earned his PhD at the University of Toronto in Near Eastern archaeology. He is also Co-director of CNEA and the Balu`a project, Jordan.



**Thomas (Tom) Davis**, Professor of Archaeology at Lipscomb University, is also Assoc. Director of the Lanier Center for Archaeology. For years, he was Director of the Cyprus American Archaeological Research Institute and co-directs several projects.

**Kendra Haloviak Valentine** is Professor of New Testament Studies at La Sierra University, having earned her PhD in New Testament Ethics at the Graduate Theological Union at Berkeley. She has also taught on study tours to the Middle East.



**Helmut Schwaiger** is Senior Academy Scientist at the Austrian Archaeological Institute of the Austrian Academy. In addition to excavations in Austria, Italy, and Egypt, he has been responsible for the research project: Ephesus in Post Antiquity.

**Theresa Shaw** earned a Juris Doctor degree, using it to practice law for 23 years and teach at La Verne Univ. Law School. She has volunteered in several museum settings and at CNEA, where she developed her numismatic specialization.



**Charles Anthony Stewart** is an art historian and archaeologist. He specializes in the development of Late Roman and Early Medieval architecture, especially around the Mediterranean and Central Asia, leading him to study monotheistic religions.

**Mark Wilson** is founder and Director of the Asia Minor Research Center of Antalya, Turkey, through which he has led numerous study tours of the Mediterranean world. He has a D.Litt. et Phil. degree from the University of South Africa.
