All applicants must submit the following:

- (a) A completed application which must be processed by the American Association of Colleges of Podiatric Medicine Application Service (AACPMAS). The website address is www.aacpm.org
- (b) Medical College Admission Test (MCAT) or GRE plus one subject test in Biology, Chemistry or Physics
- (c) Recommendations from the Pre-Professional Recommendation Committee (or two science faculty members) and one recommendation from a podiatric physician.

**Note: AP and CLEP exams do not meet Medical School requirements for Biology, Chemistry, or Physics. A number of medical schools will not accept any AP credit.
