**\*PHARMACY PROGRAM:** There will be four years of study at Loma Linda University to complete the Doctor of Pharmacy degree.

**\*APPLICATION TO LOMA LINDA UNIVERSITY:** Preferably, applicants will have successfully completed a Baccalaureate degree in chemistry, biology, physics or related scientific field. The minimum requirement for acceptance without a B.S. degree is complete of the Pre-Pharmacy Program described above. This usually requires two years to three years of study. Students who already have a B.S degree must insure that all of the pre-pharmacy requirements have also been completed. Courses are expected to be at the level of those required for a major in the field; introductory courses are not accepted.

The Pharmacy Program at Loma Linda University begins in the fall. The deadline to apply is Nov.1. Apply online at: <http://www.llu.edu/llu/sahp/appform.html> then click "apply."

The early consideration deadline is October 15.

**GPA:** Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 2.75 on a 4.00 scale to be considered.
