CERTIFICATE PROGRAMS IN RADIATION TECHNOLOGY BEYOND THE A.S DEGREE: Medical Sonography Nuclear Medicine Technology, Radiation Therapy Technology, Special Imaging Technology, and Medical Dosimetry.

RADIATION SCIENCES: (B.S): This Program emphasizes more advanced areas of Radiologic technology and is taken AFTER the completion of the Associate in Science degree program or the equivalent. The student in this program chooses an area of emphasis (administrative and education, science or clinical practice) and electives to complete 192 units.

LSU courses for transfer are the same as those for A.S. degree with the student completing the general studies requirement of 12 units cultural heritage, 12 units social sciences, minimum 6 units science/math courses not including Biology, and health education with two physical education activity courses, and 8 quarter units of religion.

WORK EXPERIENCE: 12 hours minimum volunteer, or paid experience in a radiology department is required.
