Intersegment General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC): The IGETC program is administered through the California Community colleges system and allows students to complete a series of courses that satisfies the lower-division Breadth/General Education requirements at La Sierra University. The IGETC must be certified by a community college counselor and submitted to LSU with the final transcript before the first term of enrollment at LSU.
